What is the Jonesboro Youth City Government?

The JYCG welcomes rising students in grades 8-12 to apply, serve and represent the Youth as *Mayor*, *City Council Members (6) Secretary, Treasurer, Parliamentarian, Historian (Social Media), and Committee Chairs (5).* The selected ambassadors from the Jonesboro community will acquire a greater knowledge of and appreciation for local government through active participation in that system working with Mayor, Council, Department Heads, civic clubs and service organizations to provide service and leadership opportunities. JCYG will promote community pride and eliminate potential negative influences amongst our future community leaders.

What kinds of things will JYCG do?

Students will meet monthly at City Hall to learn from and engage with various leaders in civic and community roles. They will work with their peers to discuss local issues. The JYCG will be offered travel opportunities to visit different leadership organizations such as the City Of Dublin and Stockbridge as well as opportunities to discuss with other leaders who live abroad. Senior ambassadors in the program will be privileged with shadowing a member of the City to learn about the more critical components that drive the City.

When are meetings?

Monthly meetings will be held on the third Monday of each month at 6pm at City Hall with dinner provided. Please note that some of the dates take place during the summer. This program is a comprehensive commitment. During this program, some opportunities may require the student to travel, transportation will be provided.

What does it cost?

There is no cost to the student to participate in JYCG. The City of Jonesboro and local businesses will partner to cover program costs such as the speakers, ambassador packages and refreshments.

How will JYCG Members be selected?

Members will be selected through a review and selection process. Students will need to complete an application including a recommendations and one essay.

When and where are the applications due?

Applications are due on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 27, 2023</u>. JYCG will be sworn in by the Mayor and Council on **Monday**, Oct 9th at 6:00pm.
